Example of level at the end:

100 hours : A1 → A2	80 hours : A2 → B1-	60 hours : B1 → B1+
150 hours : A1 → B1-	100 hours : A2 → B1	100 hours : B1 → B2
250 hours : A1 → B1	150 hours : A2 → B1+	150 hours : B1 → B2+
400 hours : A1 → B1+ / B2-	300 hours : A2 → B2- / B2+	300 hours : B1 → C1- / C1

80% of our students reach 1,5 - 2 levels !
